32% of organizations paid a ransom after they experienced a ransomware attack in 2021, but only **8%** got all their data back.

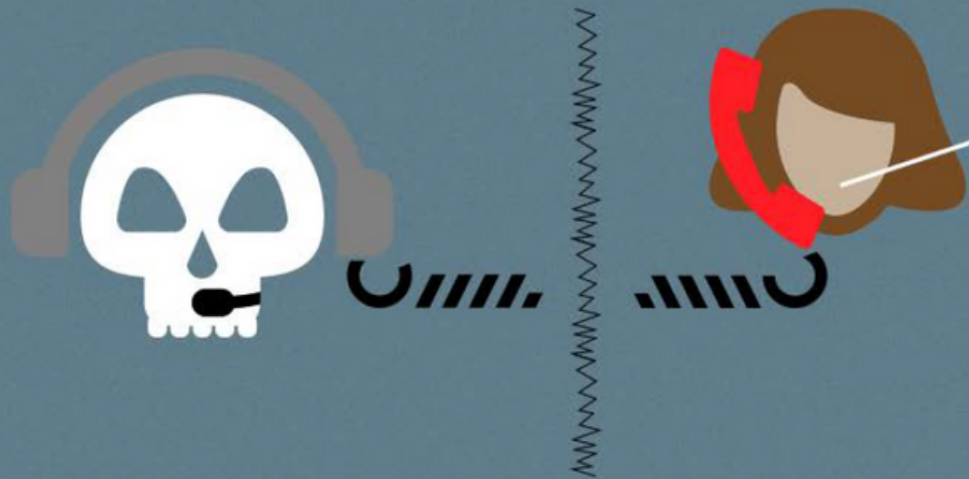




Beware of Public Wi-Fi
